On 27 July 1738, the Brigatine "Catharine", arrived at Philadelphia, Pa., with 15 immigrants aboard, among them were Hans, Ulrich Sr. & Ulrich Jr. Seiler.

No effort has been made to establish the relationship of Hans to the Ulrich Sr. & Jr., nor has any attempt been made to locate Hans after settling in the United States.

This material applies only to the descendents of Ulrich Sr. & Jr. , they being the forbearers of this researcher and compiler.

Little is available on Ulrich Sr., except that he died in Lancaster Co., Pa. in the year 1740, only being in the States about 2 years. Place of burial unknown.

Ulrich Jr. married Mary Catharine SCHMID, daughter of Henry SCHMID, to this marriage there were (3) three children; Christian, Mary Elizabeth & Benedict. It must be assumed that Mary Catharine died at an early age. We did not locate any dates as to birth, marriage or death of Mary Catharine. However, according to Court Records of Lancaster Co. Pa. at the time of Ulrich Jr. second marriage, he was a Widower and a linen weaver by trade.

And if it shall bereafter appear that any last Will and Testament was made by the said Deceased, and the Executor or Executors therein named, do exhibit the same into the Register's Office making Requies to have it allowed and approved accordingly; if the the Executor or Executors therein named, do exhibit the lame into the Register's United and Salary and the faid Editor of the faid Letters of Administration (Approbation of such Testament being first had and made in the said Register's Office) then this Obligation to be void, and of none Effect, or else to remain in tell Force and Vision 18. in full Force and Virtue. The second marriage was to Elizabeth GUISIE/GEESEY, daughter of Jacob. They were married 16 Apr. 1750 at First Reformed Church, Lancaster, Pa. According to New Holland, Lancaster Co., church records, Elizabeth was born in 1734. There were (3) three brothers; Philip, John & Henry. After the death of Ulrich, Jr. Elizabeth remarried to Henry GROFF/GROVE.

To the marriage of Ulrich Jr. & Elizabeth was added (8) eight children; Peter, Catharine, Casper, Barbara, William, George, Henry & Ulrich

Ulrich Jr. died in 1771 (see letter of Administration). He settled in York Co., immediately following his second marriage, as the first child of this marriage, Peter, was christened in 1753 at Christ Lutheran Church, York, Pa. His burial site is unknown.
