On 27 July 1738, the Brigantine "Catharine", arrived at Philadelphia, Pa., with 15 immigrants aboard, among them were Hans, Ulrich Sr. & Ulrich Jr. Seiler.

No effort has been made to establish the relationship of Hans to the Ulrich Sr. & Jr., nor has any attempt been made to locate Hans after settling in the United States.

This material applies only to the descendents of Ulrich Sr. & Jr., they being the forbearers of this researcher and compiler.

Little is available on Ulrich Sr., except that he died in Lancaster Co., Pa. in the year 1740, only being in the States about 2 years. Place of burial unknown.

Ulrich Jr. married Mary Catharine SCHMID, daughter of Henry SCHMID, to this marriage there were (3) three children; Christian, Mary Elizabeth & Benedict. It must be assumed that Mary Catharine died at an early age. We did not locate any dates as to birth, marriage or death of Mary Catharine. However, according to Court Records of Lancaster Co. Pa. at the time of Ulrich Jr. second marriage, he was a Widower and a linen weaver by trade.

ULRICH SEILER DESCENDENTS

KNOW all Men by these Presents, that We *Elizabeth Seiler* (widow of *Ulrich Seiler*) do hereby certify that

all of the County of York, and Province of Pennsylvania, are held and firmly bound unto *Benjamin Rose* Esq; Register General for the Probate of Wills, and granting Letters of Administration in the Province of Pennsylvania, in the Sum of *Three Hundred* Pounds, lawful Money of the said Province, to be paid unto the said *Benjamin Rose* or to his certain Attorney, Executors, Administrators, or Assigns. To the which Payment well and truly to be made, We do bind ourselves jointly and severally, our Heirs, Executors, and Administrators, each, and every of them, firmly by these Presents. Sealed with our Seals, and dated this *twelfth* Day of *January* in the Year of our Lord, One Thousand Seven Hundred and *Seventy*

THE Condition of the above Obligation is such, That if the above bounden *Elizabeth Seiler*

Administratrix of all and singular the Goods and Chattles, and Credits, of *Ulrich Seiler* deceased, do make, or cause to be made, a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the Goods and Chattles, and Credits, of the said Deceased, which have, or shall come to the Hands, Possession or Knowledge of the said *Elizabeth Seiler* or into the Hands or Possession of any other Person or Persons forth, and the same so made, do exhibit, or cause to be exhibited, into the Register's Office in the County of York, at or before the *twelfth* Day of *January* next ensuing, and the same Goods, Chattles, and Credits, and all other Goods, Chattles, and Credits, of the said Deceased, at the Time of his Death, which at any Time after, shall come to the Hands or Possession of the said *Elizabeth Seiler* or into the Hands or Possession of any other Person or Persons for her well and truly administer, according to law; And further, do make, or cause to be made, a true and just Account of said Administration, at or before the *twelfth* Day of *January* next, which will be in the Year of our Lord, One Thousand Seven Hundred and *Seventy*, and all the Rest and Relidue of the said Goods, Chattles and Credits, which shall be found remaining upon the said Administrators Account (the same being first examined and allowed of by the Orphans Court of the County aforesaid) do deliver and pay unto such Person or Persons respectively, as the said Orphans Court by their Decree or Sentence (pursuant to the true Intent and Meaning of an Act, intituled, *An Act for the better settling Intestates Estates*) shall limit and appoint. And if it shall hereafter appear that any last Will and Testament was made by the said Deceased, and the Executor or Executors therein named, do exhibit the same into the Register's Office at *York*, making Request to have it allowed and approved accordingly; if the said *Elizabeth Seiler* above bounden being thereunto required, do render and deliver the said Letters of Administration (Approbation of such Testament being first had and made in the said Register's Office) then this Obligation to be void, and of none Effect, or else to remain in full Force and Virtue.

ULRICH SAILOR - ADMINISTRATION BOND

The second marriage was to Elizabeth GUISSIE/GEESEY, daughter of Jacob. They were married 16 Apr. 1750 at First Reformed Church, Lancaster, Pa. According to New Holland, Lancaster Co., church records, Elizabeth was born in 1734. There were (3) three brothers; Philip, John & Henry. After the death of Ulrich, Jr. Elizabeth remarried to Henry GROFF/GROVE.

To the marriage of Ulrich Jr. & Elizabeth was added (8) eight children; Peter, Catharine, Casper, Barbara, William, George, Henry & Ulrich

Ulrich Jr. died in 1771 (see letter of Administration). He settled in York Co., immediately following his second marriage, as the first child of this marriage, Peter, was christened in 1753 at Christ Lutheran Church, York, Pa. His burial site is unknown.
